COVID-19 IN COMESA

This bring to **890** the total number of cases with **97** recoveries and **33** deaths.

The first case was reported on 14 February 2020, and the number remained low until 8 March 2020 when a notable increase was recorded of 51. Since then, the numbers have accelerated steadily with **839** new cases bringing the tally to 890. The countries most affected are Egypt and Tunisia with over **70%** of the cases.

The latest country to report its first case was Libya bringing to 18 the total number of Member States affected out the 21. Burundi, Comoros and Malawi have not recorded any case.


COMESA in collaboration with its partners continues to monitor and provide support to Member States to strengthen response and enhance awareness.

Current Risk Assessment

The continued increase of the numbers of COVID-19 cases poses a risk to Member States based on the evidence that the virus is transmitted through human to human contact. While the majority of the cases are mainly in the capital cities, the situation may worsen if the infections expand to highly populated peri-urban and rural areas. Therefore, Member States, among other measures, are urged to continue strengthening surveillance, tracking and isolation of cases.



Prevention Measures Put in Place by COMESA Secretariat



- · Maintaining a safe and healthy work environment




