

AFRICA SURPASSES ONE MILLION MARK OF COVID-19 CASES

A frica has now crossed the one million mark in terms of COVID-19 cases since the first case was recorded in February 2020. As of 12th August 2020, the total cases recorded on the continent were at 1,069,438. The countries with the highest numbers of cases include South Africa (566,109), Egypt (95,834), Nigeria (47,290), Ghana (41,404), Algeria (36,204), Morocco (35,195), Kenya (27,425) and Ethiopia (24,175). While Africa has crossed the one million mark, the percentage of cases on the continent is still very low at 5.2% in comparison to the global figure of over 20 million infections.



Also noticeable is that the trend of recoveries has been increasing. As of 12th August the continent had recorded 762,013 total recoveries. This number of recoveries represents 71.25% of the total number of COVID-19 cases recorded. These high numbers of recoveries in Africa can be attributed to enhanced testing, tracing, isolation and treatment, experience in handling earlier cases which has provided key lessons in terms of managing newly detected infections. In addition, the lessons from dealing with earlier epidemics has provided best practices for handling COVID-19 cases. Equally, the total numbers of COVID-19 related deaths have been very low (23,920) which constitutes 0.2% of the total recorded cases in the continent.

The cases in the COMESA region constitute 21.06% of the total infections recorded in the continent. Currently, the region has recorded a total of 225,300 cases, 131,320 recoveries and 8,034 deaths. The countries with the highest numbers of cases include Egypt (95,834), Kenya (27,425), Ethiopia (24,175), Madagascar (13,397) and Sudan (12,033).
