

THE APALA ONE STOP YOUTH CENTER STORY

IN 2021 COMESA, SAVE THE CHILDREN AND HORN OF AFRICA YOUTH NETWORK ORGANIZED A HIGH-LEVEL MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE ON THE ROLE OF AU, COMESA RMS AND NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS IN PROMOTING THE YOUTH, PEACE AND SECURITY AGENDA FOR THE HORN OF AFRICA REGION. THE CONFERENCE EMPHASIZED THE NEED FOR DEDICATED SPACES WHERE YOUNG PEOPLE CAN ENGAGE, EMPOWER THEMSELVES, AND ACQUIRE VOCATIONAL AND PEACE-BUILDING SKILLS. FOLLOWING THE CONFERENCE, UGANDA AND DJIBOUTI WERE IDENTIFIED FOR PILOT YOUTH CENTERS, WITH UGANDA'S APALA CHOSEN AS THE REGIONAL HUB FOR EAST AFRICA AND THE HORN OF AFRICA.

PARTNERSHIPS PLAYED A PIVOTAL ROLE IN ESTABLISHING THE YOUTH CENTER, WITH COMESA, THE UGANDAN GOVERNMENT, UGANDAN NATIONAL YOUTH COUNCIL, HORN OF AFRICA YOUTH NETWORK, EPUKA UGAIDI, AND SAVE THE CHILDREN COLLABORATING ON INFRASTRUCTURE, TECHNOLOGY, LIBRARY SETUP, AND TRAINING A MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE. THE PROCESS WAS YOUTH-LED AND YOUTH-FOCUSED, ENSURING THAT THE CENTER WAS DEVELOPED BY AND FOR YOUNG PEOPLE. IT SERVES AS A BEACON OF HOPE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR THE YOUTH IN THE REGION.

SPECIAL THANKS TO UNESCO FOR SUPPORTING THE CENTRE WITH UP-TO-DATE BOOKS ACROSS VARIOUS GENRES. ON DECEMBER 20TH, 2023, THE CENTER WAS OFFICIALLY HANDED OVER TO ITS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE, WHICH IS NOW FULLY OPERATIONAL. IN MARCH 2024, THE COMMITTEE HELD ITS FIRST YOUTH IT TRAINING, ATTRACTING 60 PARTICIPANTS AND SHOWCASING THE CENTER'S IMPACT IN TRANSFORMING LIVES AND LIVELIHOODS.

WITH THE SUPPORT OF COMESA AND SAVE THE CHILDREN, THE APALA YOUTH CENTER TECH HUB IS EQUIPPED WITH 10 COMPUTERS, A 43-INCH TELEVISION SCREEN, A PRINTER, AND NETWORKING EQUIPMENT PROVIDING INTERNET COVERAGE TO THE CENTER AND ITS SURROUNDINGS. THE COMPUTERS OPERATE ON WINDOWS 11 AND ARE EQUIPPED WITH THE LATEST KASPERSKY ANTIVIRUS SOFTWARE AND A FIREWALL THAT FILTERS OUT INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT. FUTURE PLANS INCLUDE ESTABLISHING A DIGITAL LIBRARY HOSTED ON THE CLOUD WITH REGULARLY UPDATED CONTENT, SUCH AS BOOKS AND EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES.
















APALA ONE-STOP YOUTH CENTER LAUCH DAY
